Dr. Shalini Goyal Presented her views on NHEQF India has a comprehensive higher education system with diverse educational institutions and programs of study. Our Country needs to develop a nationally accepted and internationally comparable and acceptable qualification framework.

- 1. The national higher education framework proposes to lay down an integrated national framework for different types of institutions engaged in higher education.
- 2. Provide proper guidance to education providers for setting of academic standards, designing curricula, teaching learning strategies etc
- 3. Help students, parents and stake holders to understand the nature and level of expected learning outcomes.
- 4. To ensure public's confidence in the prospect of higher education qualifications and academic standards.
- 5. Provide necessary impetus to individual's life long learning goal.

Dr. Anshumati presented her views on Internationalization of Education and Indian Knowledge System Views on Institutional preparedness on academic research and internationalization of higher education

- Focused areas of research
- Brief information about the course of action for the research to be carried out
- Faculty detail vis-à-vis research topic
- Facilities required for the research to be carried out along with detail of the facilities available in institution and new facilities

For internationalization of higher education Journals/e-journals of international repute will be required to acquaint the faculty about the recent researches at global level. Participation of faculty members in international academic events shall bring global teaching pedagogy and knowledge to the classrooms of the College.

2. Views on Indian Knowledge System and institutional preparedness for introducing Indian Knowledge System.

For introduction of Indian Knowledge System at institution level:

Each faculty member of the institution should be essentially nominated to attend workshops about Indian Knowledge System being organised by Ministry of Education. It shall not only familiarize them with the already researched ancient Indian Knowledge but also lead them towards the ways and methods of research about it. Efforts need to be made at institution level to research about the regional ancient knowledge concepts and to publish it so that such old regional knowledge become part of Indian Knowledge System and may reach to the masses.

About Academic Bank of Credit

The scheme has the provisions of creating a digital infrastructure that will store the academic credits earned by the students of various higher education institutes within the country.

Students will have to manually open an account with the Academic Bank of Credit of India.

The bank will start functioning with over 290 top Indian higher education institutions participating in the academic session 2021-2022.

## Features, and Functions of Academic Bank of Credit

- The scheme will include all kinds of courses offered by the Higher Education Institutes and which are recognised by the <u>University Grants Commission (UGC)</u>, be it a graduation course, postgraduate course, PhD courses, diploma courses, certificate courses, etc.
- It covers courses offered through any medium, be it regular classroom courses or open/distance learning courses or online courses.

	<ul> <li>SWAYAM, NPTEL, V-Lab and such other schemes offering their courses are also eligible to avail the facilities provided by Academic Bank of Credit.</li> <li>In general the credits earned by students will carry a validity of 7 years unless otherwise specified for that particular course; and upon the end of the validity period these credits will expire.</li> <li>The ABC will not accept any kind of credit course document by the students but rather only from the higher education institution he/she is enrolled in.
